He shall then slaughter the goat for the sin offering for the people and take its blood behind the curtain and do with it as he did with the bull's blood: He shall sprinkle it on *the atonement cover* and in front of it.

(Leviticus 16:15)

God presented Christ as a sacrifice of atonement, through the shedding of his blood–to be received by faith. (Romans 3:25)

God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Since we have now been justified by his blood, how much more shall we be saved from God's wrath through him! For if, while we were God's enemies, we were reconciled to him through the death of his Son, how much more, having been reconciled, shall we be saved through his life!
