You have not received a spirit of slavery leading to fear again, but you have received a spirit of adoption.  
 (Romans 8:15, NASB)

The Spirit you received brought about your adoption to sonship. ... Now if we are children, then we are heirs— heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ. (Romans 8:15, 17)

When he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all the truth.  
 (John 16:13)

The Spirit you received does not make you slaves, so that you live in fear again; rather, the Spirit you received brought about your adoption to sonship. And by him we cry, "Abba, Father." The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children.  
 (Romans 8:15-16)

For if you live according to the flesh, you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the misdeeds of the body, you will live. For those who are led by the Spirit of God are the children of God.  
 (Romans 8:13-14)

What we have received is not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, so that we may understand what God has freely given us. ... The person without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God but considers them foolishness, and cannot understand them because they are discerned only through the Spirit. (1 Corinthians 2:12, 14)

The Spirit also helps our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we should, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for us. ... and He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He intercedes for the saints according to *the will* of God.
